

- Harvest flowers when they've bloomed, but before they wilt. Use the flowers fresh or frozen.
- 2. Mordant your fibre (see the Mordanting card).
- 3. Soak your wool (see the Mordanting card).

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- 4. Weigh your flowers. You need equal weights of flowers to fibre.
- 5. Put flowers in cheese cloth and drop them in a non-reactive pot, then cover with water.
- 6. Heat until steam appears, but do not let simmer (30 mins: start counting time when the water has reached the desired temperature).
- 7. Let sit overnight for a deeper colour OR remove the flowers for a lighter colour.
- 8. Add the wool to the dye created and heat until steam appears, but do not let simmer (30 mins).
- 9.*Optional: let sit from 1 to 12 hours to absorb maximum colour.
- 10. Rinse in water of the same temperature to avoid felting (for wool).
- 11. Air dry away from direct sunlight.
